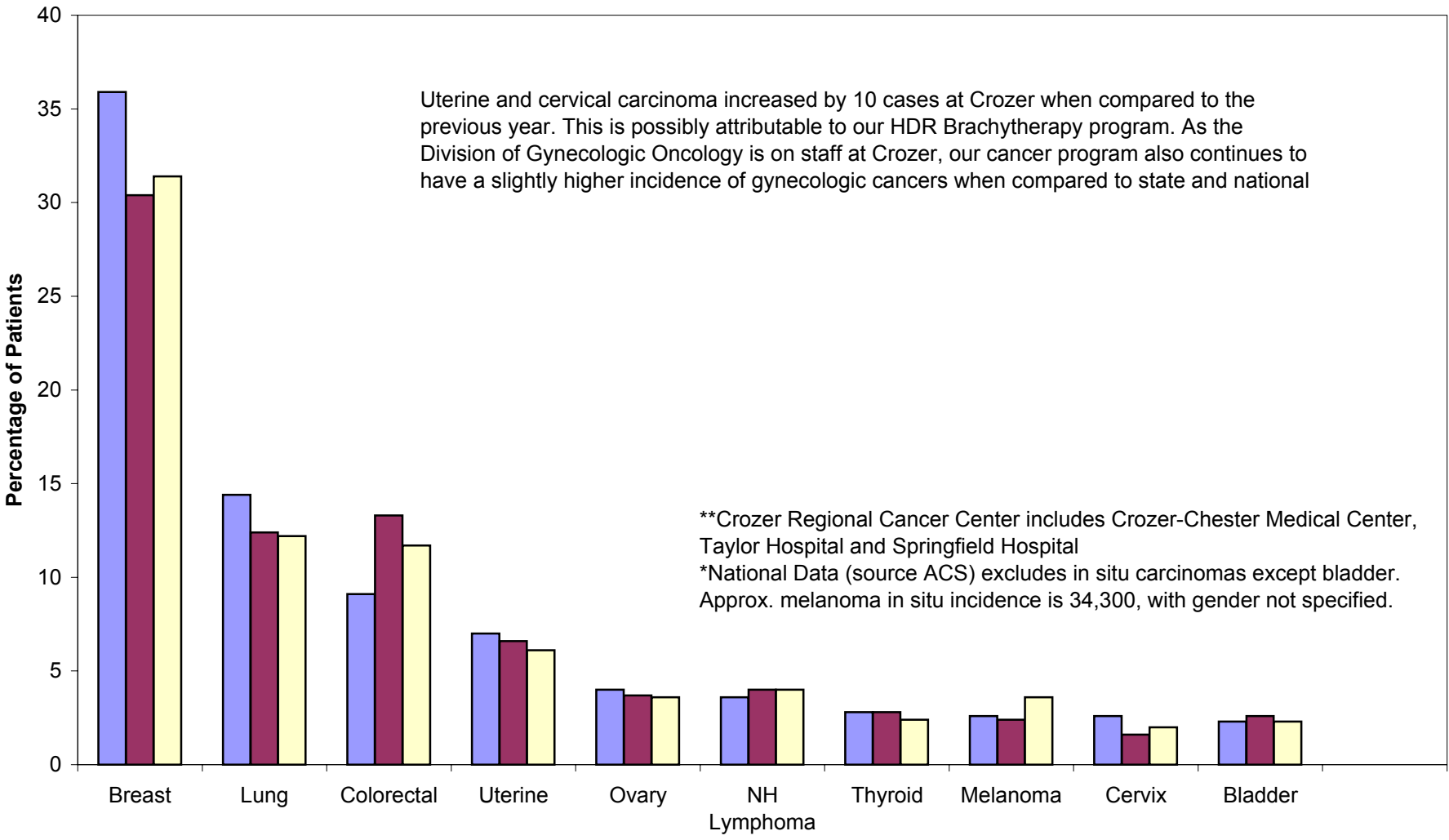

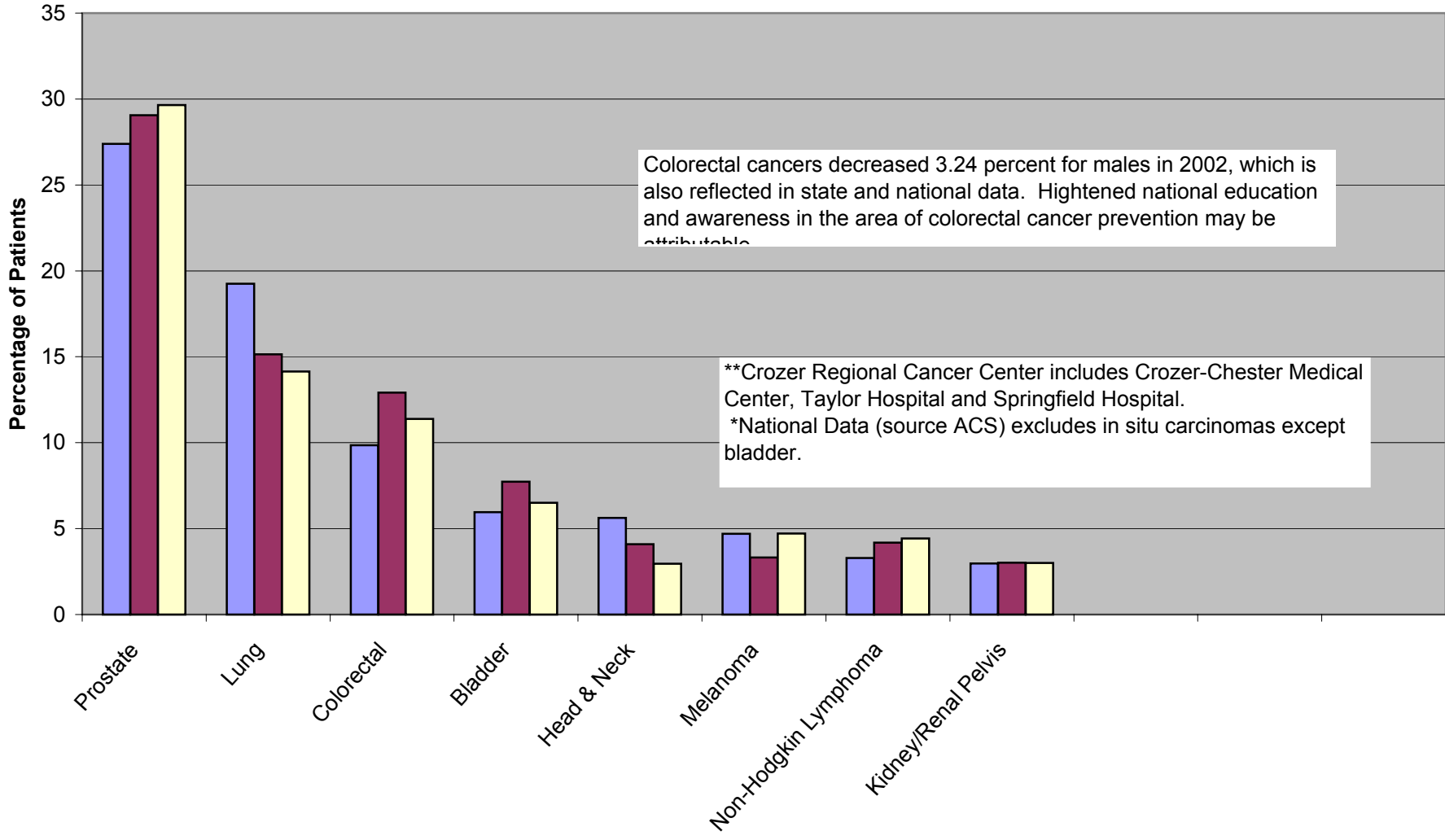
2002 Cancer Comparison - Female

ACOS Physician Liaison

As the Cancer Liaison Physician, I serve as a volunteer who is responsible for providing the leadership and direction to establish, maintain and support our facility's cancer program.

Some of the key activities I perform as Cancer Liaison Physician include promotion of Crozer's cancer program by working with the cancer committee to publicize approval by the Commission on Cancer and communicate the benefits of approval to the medical staff and community. I am an active member of the cancer committee of Crozer's Commission on Cancer-approved cancer program and actively participate in cancer conferences and tumor board presentations at Crozer on a regular basis. At Crozer, we use National Cancer Database information to identify areas for improvement in care and illustrate our cancer program successes.

As Cancer Liaison Physician, I spearhead initiatives to comply with Commission on Cancer standards and encourage routine participation in cancer conference and tumor boards by all required disciplines at Crozer, especially surgery. Additionally, I attend Cancer Liaison Program meetings held in conjunction with the American College of Surgeons Clinical Congress, and look forward to strengthening our relationships with local American Cancer Society. This is achieved by working with Crozer's cancer committee to monitor community outreach activities, as well as working with the Community Outreach Coordinator at Crozer to organize supportive services on-site or with local agencies.

With my strong commitment to the success of the cancer program and to the quality of care provided to patients with cancer, I am happy to serve as Crozer's Cancer Liaison Physician.

Tumor Conferences

In 2002, the Weekly Tumor Conferences at Crozer-Chester Medical Center and the monthly Clinical Cancer Conferences at Taylor Hospital presented a total of 175 cases for consultation; 164 of which were prospective cases, with the remaining 11 cases being retrospective. Ovary was the most common site presented.

These conferences remain a major education element for the cancer programs, with an average attendance of 25 participants representing radiation oncology, surgery, gynecologic oncology, medical oncology, diagnostic radiology, pathology, urologic oncology, nursing, medical education and ancillary services.

Crozer-Chester Medical Center also conducts a weekly Breast Review Panel in addition to the Tumor Conferences. In 2002, 168 cases were presented for consultation – 167 were prospective and one was retrospective. On average, there were 15 participants.
